



Spectator Rules

The purchase of a ticket for admission to the event grounds (hereinafter referred to as the grounds) de Kilomètre Lancé (Engadin Airport, including paddock and riding arena St. Moritz) implies the acceptance of the following terms and conditions according to which Intern. St. Moritzer Automobilwochen AG grants admission to the grounds and the event.

§ 1 - ADMISSION TICKETS

1. every spectator must be in possession of a valid admission ticket. Entering the premises without a valid admission ticket is punishable by law and will result in immediate expulsion from the premises.
2. resale of tickets is strictly prohibited. If a ticket is resold without the express permission of Intern. St. Moritzer Automobilwochen AG or passed on for profit-making or commercial reasons (including as part of a promotional campaign or as a prize), this ticket will become invalid and the holder may be refused entry to the premises or expelled from the premises.
3. the tickets are only valid for the marked spectator areas, there the ticket does not grant any right to a certain seat or standing place.
4. tickets remain valid even if the event is postponed to another date for reasons beyond the organizer's control. A return is excluded.
5. if an event is cancelled, there is no right to a refund unless no significant part of the event has elapsed before the event was cancelled. If the holder is entitled to a partial claim, the Intern. St. Moritzer Automobilwochen AG will determine the share at its reasonable discretion. 6.
6. any claim for repayment of the entrance fee must be made in writing within a preclusion period of six months - beginning with the end of the last day of the event. The claim shall become time-barred six months after written assertion.
7. the Intern. St. Moritzer Automobilwochen AG uses CCTV cameras to secure the premises. You give your consent for any footage to be taken for general security purposes. You also give your consent

for Intern. St. Moritzer Automobilwochen AG may use the CCTV footage in any legal matter or pass it on to the police.

8. the creation, storage, recording or transmission of any kind of sound recordings, visual material or audiovisual material (hereinafter referred to as recordings) of, during or in connection with the event is not permitted. It is also prohibited to store, record or transmit any information or data, including official timing, results, performances, weather or race management data (hereinafter referred to as data). Any type of equipment capable of performing the aforementioned actions is prohibited on the premises. Private electronic devices (including cameras, cell phones and other portable devices for private communication) are allowed on the premises unless otherwise specified. This is under the condition that any recordings, data as well as any visual material including photographs and any kind of still images that can be created from a recording of the event, that are recorded, stored and/or created in the aftermath of the event, are used exclusively for personal, private and non-commercial purposes.

9. by entering the premises you agree that a) the use of the aforementioned recordings, data and images for any form of public advertising, display, commercial gain or any other purpose (except private use) without the prior written consent of Intern. St. Moritzer Automobilwochen AG is strictly prohibited and constitutes a breach of the terms and conditions for which you may be held liable, and b) that upon request of Intern. St. Moritzer Automobilwochen AG the exclusive right of use and any intellectual property in any visual material or any recordings made, created, stored or recorded by you of, during or in connection with the event, in writing to Intern. St. Moritzer Automobilwochen AG in writing.

10. should there be short-term capacity restrictions due to changes in official requirements to combat the corona pandemic and a reduction in the number of spectators is necessary, the "first come, first serve" principle will apply - admission will be granted on a first come, first served basis. In this case, affected spectators will be informed in time about a possible ticket refund.

11. personal data information: We collect, if ordered by the authorities, first and last names, address, date of birth, telephone number, e-mail address as well as health data within the meaning of Art. 9 DS-GVO in the context of ticket acquisition and in the context of accreditation: Recognized test result (Covid 19: PCR & PoC antigen rapid test), information on vaccination status (vaccination card) as well as proof of survived COVID 19 infection (so-called proof of recovery) of the spectator (card user). The data collection is done for the purpose of tracing infection chains related to the Covid 19 pandemic. The legal basis for data collection and processing are the provisions of the current Corona Protection Ordinance in force in the Canton of Graubünden. A transmission of the above-mentioned data takes place to the responsible public health department, exclusively on its request and for the purpose of tracing infection chains as well as to inform the persons concerned and to order infection protection measures. The data will be stored digitally or in paper form for four weeks from the date of the event. Afterwards, they will be deleted and destroyed by us.

§ 2 - SECURITY & SPECTATOR AREA

1. depending on the capacity of the spectator areas, minimum distances between spectators shall be observed.

2. the orders of the race management, the stewards and the barrier personnel are to be obeyed without fail. Failure to do so means trespassing.

3. no bulky objects other than seat cushions may be taken into the grandstands.
4. do not climb over the safety equipment! Otherwise you endanger yourself and others.
5. Open fire and the shooting of pyrotechnic objects (such as rockets, firecrackers, Bengal light, etc.) are strictly prohibited. Otherwise you endanger other spectators, event participants and last but not least yourself to a high degree.
6. Weapons and weapon-like objects may not be brought onto the event premises.
7. it is forbidden to bring animals into the event area. This does not apply to dogs, which must be kept on a leash.
- 8) It is not permitted to bring your own food and drinks into the grandstand areas or the paddock.
9. the premises will be monitored by video cameras in some areas. The video surveillance of the premises serves the purpose of security, the preservation of domiciliary rights, as well as the prevention and clarification of criminal offences.

§ 3 - PROTECTION & HYGIENE

In order to minimize the risk of transmission and infection with the Corona virus (SARS-CoV-2), all applicable protection and hygiene measures must be fully followed.

1. general hygiene: observe the sneezing and coughing etiquette in consideration of the other participants and visitors. Use the hand disinfection dispensers provided. On-site signs and announcements remind people of the hygiene rules. Individuals with cold symptoms who are not feeling well and/or have had contact with COVID-19 sufferers are prohibited from attending the event.

2. the admission requirements are based on the federal law for the protection against infections as well as on the valid corona control ordinance of the canton of Grisons.

The quarantine and travel regulations are to be taken from the version of the Corona Control Ordinance of the Swiss government current at the time of the event.

4. access to the event location is currently only possible via the so-called "3 G" principle. This means for a) negative tested, b) vaccinated, c) recovered. The test obligation can be fulfilled by a PCR test as well as a PoC antigen rapid test.

5. our entry and wayfinding system will allow you to keep a sufficient distance from other people at all times.

6. Sanitation and Elevators: Our restrooms may only be used with the number of people indicated on the doors at one time. Our staff is instructed to ensure this. Please do not forget to wash your hands!

7. CORONA WARN APP: We strongly recommend that all visitors use the official Corona Warn apps for their own safety.

8. we point out that we are entitled and obliged to exclude people from the event who do not comply with the protection and hygiene measures.

9. use the provided waste garbage cans for your waste and please separate your waste as described on the garbage cans.

§ 4 - LIABILITY

You hereby acknowledge that racing, this event and certain related activities (including, without limitation, the fringe events) are hazardous. The Intern. St. Moritzer Automobilwochen AG, the licensing authorities, as well as persons involved in the organization of the event (including officially appointed persons, marshals and rescue and medical personnel), competitors and drivers (this group also includes, where relevant, all managers, directors, employees, agents, suppliers and affiliates) are not responsible for any loss or damage caused to you or your property. This applies to loss or damage to the maximum extent permitted by Swiss law (without limiting or excluding from this provision (i) liability for death and personal injury caused by the negligence of any of the foregoing or (ii) any loss or damage caused by fraud or fraudulent misrepresentation by any of the foregoing). In return, the Intern. St. Moritzer Automobilwochen AG will take out a spectator accident insurance in favor of the holder for damages caused by race-participating vehicles during the training and sprint runs.

§ 5 - FIRST AID

§ 6 - Photo and video recordings at public events

We expressly point out that photos and video recordings will be made during this event. We will use these for reporting and public relations purposes. For this purpose, the recordings will be published in various local, national, international and media, such as internet presence (www.kilometrelance.com and others), trade journals and our social media channels.

Recipients of this data are thus internally our employees entrusted with public relations and externally the regional press as well as editorial offices and editorial systems of print media, online media and internationally operating social media providers.

By attending our event, you expressly consent to the use of your image (photo and video data) for the above-mentioned purposes.
